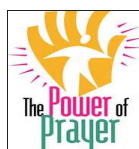
**Food Pantry Collection**

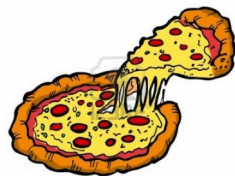
