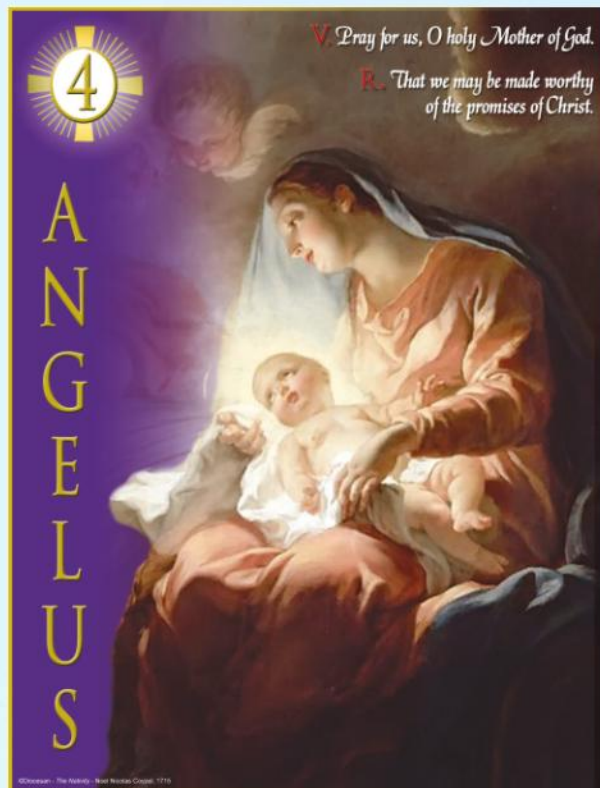

From Bishop Hurley: A dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of obligation for the people in the Diocese of Gaylord until further notice. I do so that anyone who needs to stay home to protect the common good, themselves and others can do so in good conscience...

The granting of this dispensation is not meant to be a reason to absent oneself from Mass (for other reasons). Conscience will always need to be our guide. If you are able to do so, I invite you to come back to the parish celebrations. Whether we are able to attend or not, we have a serious obligation to "Keep holy the Sabbath day." If you are not able to attend Mass, I ask that you set aside time for prayer, not only everyday but especially on Sunday.

The corporals, purificators once purified and laundered, and the altar towel used for the ritual washing of hands, would need to be starched and pressed. Washing would be once a week. 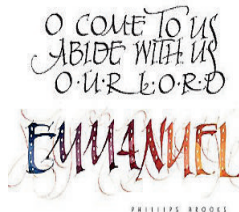

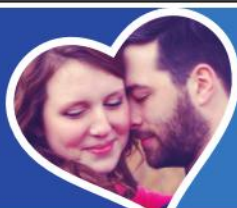
