#### Sat the 5th/Sun the 6th

3:15 pm / 8:15 am - Exposition of the Most Blessed Sacrament and silent adoration

3:30 pm / 8:30 am - Continued silent adoration, or readings, reflections, other

3:55 pm / 8:55 am - (approximately) Recitation of the Rosary of the Most Blessed Virgin Mary

4:15 pm / 9:15 am - Simple Reposition of the Most Blessed Sacrament, preparation for Holy Mass

During these times Father will observe the regular confession times. Please show respect to our Eucharistic Lord exposed on the altar, and consideration for others seeking silent adoration times by keeping all conversation during Eucharistic Exposition to a minimum, necessary amount throughout the church, including the entrance-way.


