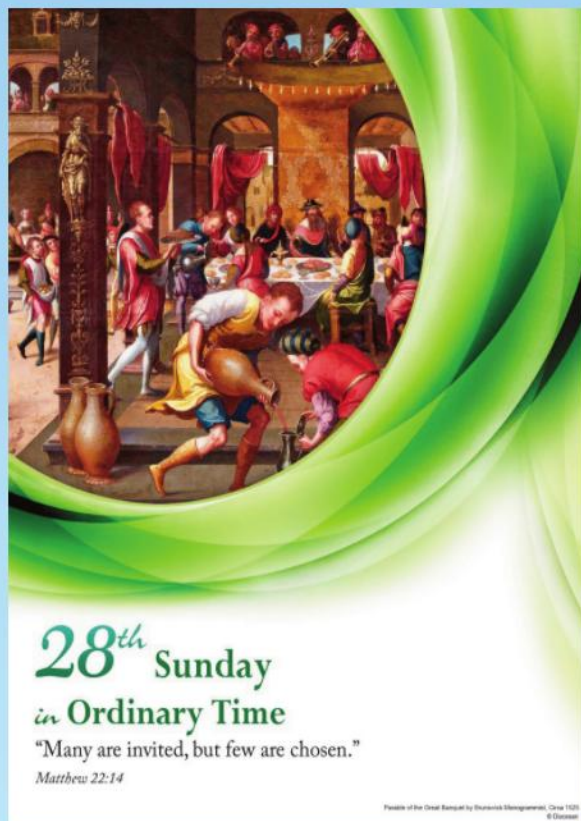

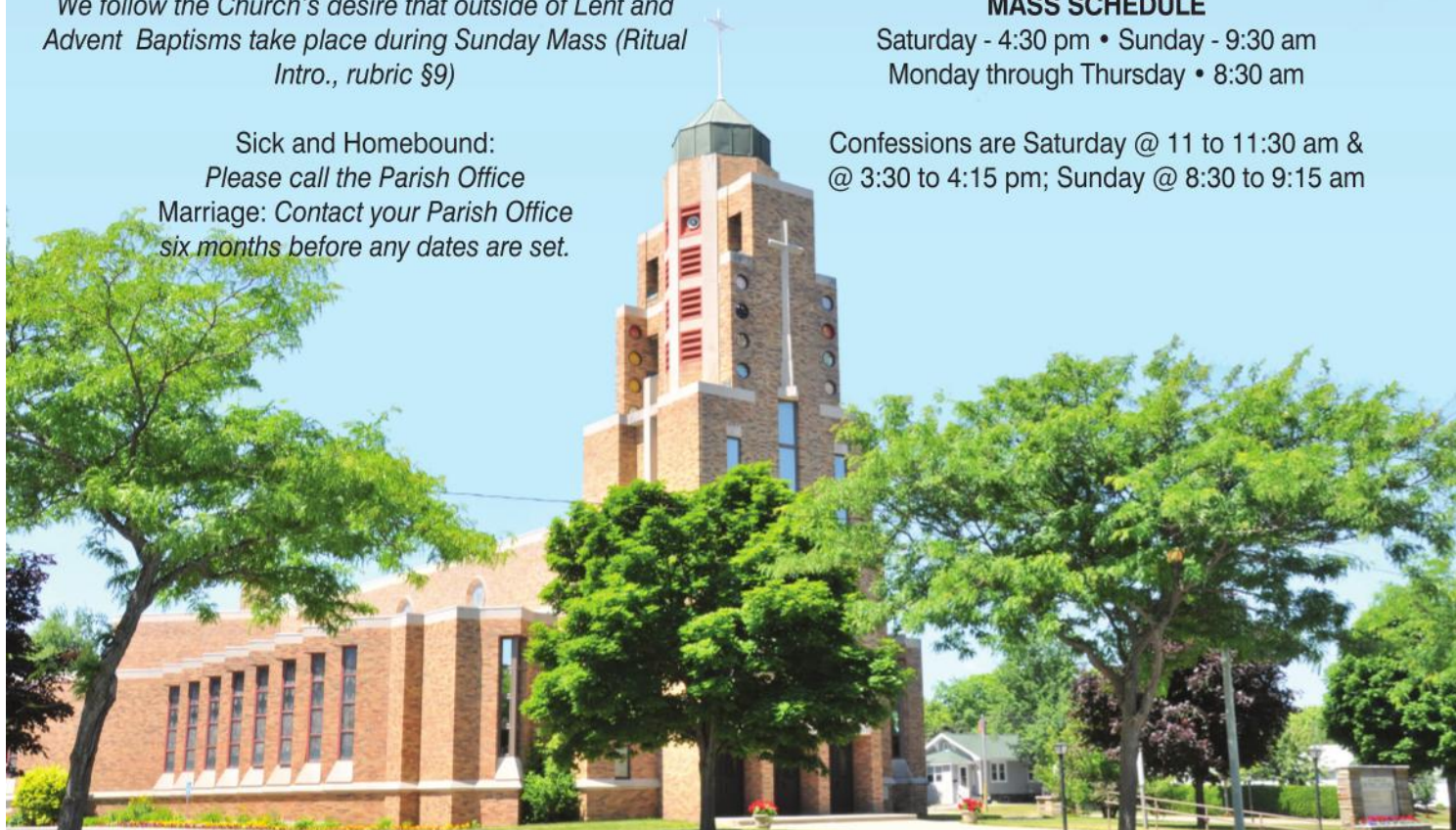

PLEASE call ahead to enroll yourself or your family. We are required by the Health Department to obtain a name and a contact number for each person/family who comes to Mass. *Calling ahead really helps us be better prepared and prevents a line up at the door of the church. Even with the addition of walk-ins who do not call in or miss the time slot to call in, walk-ins have not been turned away.* The parish office will take calls **Monday - Thursday, 9:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. to register @ 989-734-2753.** If you enroll and later find that you cannot attend Mass, call the office between Monday - Thursday, to allow the opportunity for others to attend. *We are expected to wear a Mask!*

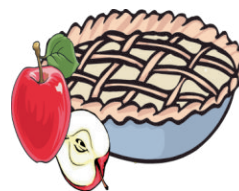

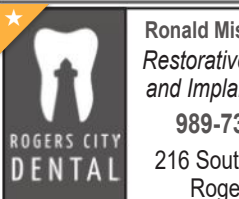
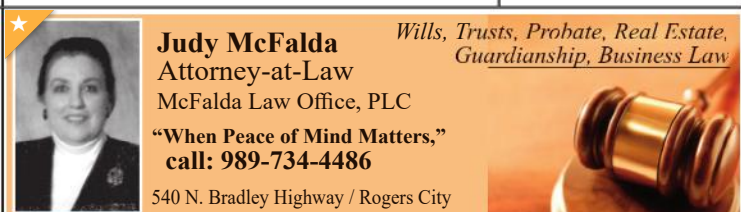
