

TO THE PARENTS OF OUR YOUNG CHILDREN, may we suggest:

Relax! God put the wiggle in children, don't feel you have to suppress it completely in God's house.

Sit toward the front where it's easier to see and hear what's going on at the altar. They tire of seeing the backs of others' heads.

Use a gentle touch, an arm around your child's shoulder, your hand in his/her to give reassurance and appropriate attention.

Quietly explain the parts of the Mass and actions of the priest, altar servers, choir, etc. Sing hymns, pray, voice the responses. Children learn liturgical behavior by copying you.

If you need to leave Mass with your child feel free to do so. But, please come back. As Jesus said, "Let the children come to me."

Always remember that the way we welcome children in church directly affects the way they respond to church, God, and one another. Let them know that they are at home in this house of worship.
