

On Monday, November 9, the Most Reverend Bishop Walter Hurley as Apostolic

Administrator of the Diocese wrote:

I am extending the dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of obligation for the people in the Diocese of Gaylord until further notice. I do so that anyone who needs to stay home to protect the common good, themselves and others can do so in good conscience...

The granting of this dispensation is not meant to be a reason to absent oneself from Mass (for other reasons). Conscience will always need to be our guide. If you are able to do so, I invite you to come back to the parish celebrations. Whether we are able to attend or not, we have a serious obligation to "Keep holy the Sabbath day." If you are not able to attend Mass, I ask that you set aside time for prayer, not only everyday but especially on Sunday.

EXTENSION OF CERTAIN PLENARY INDULGENCES

1 and 8 p.m.

In the month of November, the Church has two traditional means of obtaining a plenary indulgence for the souls in Purgatory. The first is to visit a cemetery and pray for the dead during the Octave of All Saints Day, Nov. 1-8). The second is connected to the Feast of All Soul's Day (Nov. 2), and can be received by those who piously visit a church or oratory on that day and recite the Our Father and the Creed. This year, the Vatican has decreed that these plenary indulgences can be obtained on any day in November to reduce crowds.
