



Please Remember Our Parish in a Day of Prayer and Penance Wednesday, February 9

" 'What are we to do?' " (Luke 3:10)

The purpose of this day is self-denial so we may be inclined to love those who participate with us in our parochial meetings and listen to each other. This aspect of synodality or a pilgrimage faith together for discerning what the Holy Spirit inspires the local Church of Gaylord to do develop parishes for mission. Self-denial helps us reign in our personal interests and yield to the needs of the whole community. Self-denial is necessary to tailor our personal visions of a parish's purpose to an authentically Catholic vision. We should use February 9 as a day to ask the Holy Spirit in the Name of Jesus to keep us in communion with the Magisterium or teaching authority of the Universal Church, and with our Bishop-elect, the Most Reverend Jeffrey Walsh, to be ordained March 4. Meanwhile our parochial meetings will take place Sunday, February 6 and Monday, February 7 at 5:30 in the gym, so he can learn of parishes' needs for readiness to proclaim the Gospel.

Here are some ideas meant to stir some thoughts of our own ideas:

Research the Catechism of the Catholic Church (promulgated in 1992) or https://www.vatican.va/archive/catechism it/index it.htm any areas of the Church's doctrine that are hard to accept, and pray for the gift of understanding.

Fast from all but one meal that day.

Abstain from meat that day.

Abstain from a favorite beverage, dessert, or snack.

Abstain from a favorite recreation.

Offer an additional Rosary or a devotion personally important that the Holy Spirit come among us with gifts of truth and unity the days of our meetings.

Offer an action of charity for the good of someone else for the intention of our communion in Christ, the way and the truth and the life (John 14:16).

Consider exercising your chosen penance each Wednesday through to Wednesday, February 22.

Having difficulty keeping a particular penance?

The same Holy Spirit we invoke for our parish, is ready to help each of us! Ask the Holy Spirit, that he send his Angels to guard us in our way of prayer and penance, and bear us up to help us overcome our difficulties, unto faithfulness and truth (Psalm 91:11).


