

Would you like to set up documentation for selecting to whom will be granted medical power of attorney, or declaring your intentions of how to treat you when you are incapacitated? Would you like the documentation to conform with the social justice teachings of the Catholic Church and to be admissible in Michigan law? The Patients' Rights Council, an advocacy group for the proper care of the chronically and terminally ill, can help by providing guidelines specific to your state of residence. AN APOSTOLATE MESSAGE FROM THE Order of Secular Discalced Carmelites (OCDS) group of Gaylord for November.

ST. ELIZABETH OF THE TRINITY was born in France on July 18, 1880. She was a strong-willed child with an unpleasant temper, but after receiving her First Communion at age eleven she gained more self-discipline and a better understanding of God. During late adolescence she became more spiritually aware of God's presence within her and entered the Carmel of Dijon at age 21. She was a spiritual writer, mystic, and gifted pianist. She is renowned for her gratitude and love of the Most Holy Trinity—the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, who were her beloved "Three". In 1904 she composed a prayer giving honor to the three persons of the Trinity. She wanted all to know about the Trinitarian dwelling place within every baptized person's soul which she referred to as the "little heaven". St. Elizabeth died on November 9, 1906 at the age of 26 from Addison's disease. She is the patron saint of the sick and the loss of parents. Her feast day is celebrated on November 8th.


