



### **INFORMATION ON THE CELEBRATION TIME OF 2021 HOLY WEEK**

**AND THE TRIDUUM** (Passed down from the Diocese of Gaylord) - Subject to Change

#### **Palm Sunday**

- This year palms will be distributed as follows: Palms will be placed singly on the communion rail on the Virgin's side of the church. **Please take any branches you touch**, for the safety of others. The branches will be blessed and holy water sprinkled on them by Father after the entrance Gospel while you hold your palms in your pew. Please do not leave your palms in the pew after Mass. You are welcome to take as many unblessed palms as you desire that are left on the communion rail after Mass. **There is no obligation to take a palm at all and still participate fully in the liturgy.**

#### **Thursday Evening Mass of the Supper of the Lord**

- The diocesan regulations for this year is that we not have the "washing of the feet" ritual.
- The procession of the Most Blessed Sacrament to the chapel of repose must be shortened this year according to diocesan policy.

#### **Good Friday of the Passion of the Lord**

- The veneration of the cross by a kiss is not permitted. Individuals may, if desiring to make a personal veneration of the cross, approach the front of the church as in the reception of Holy Communion. When it is your turn, you may, at your option, bow profoundly to the cross or genuflect in front of it. Please keep safe distancing.
