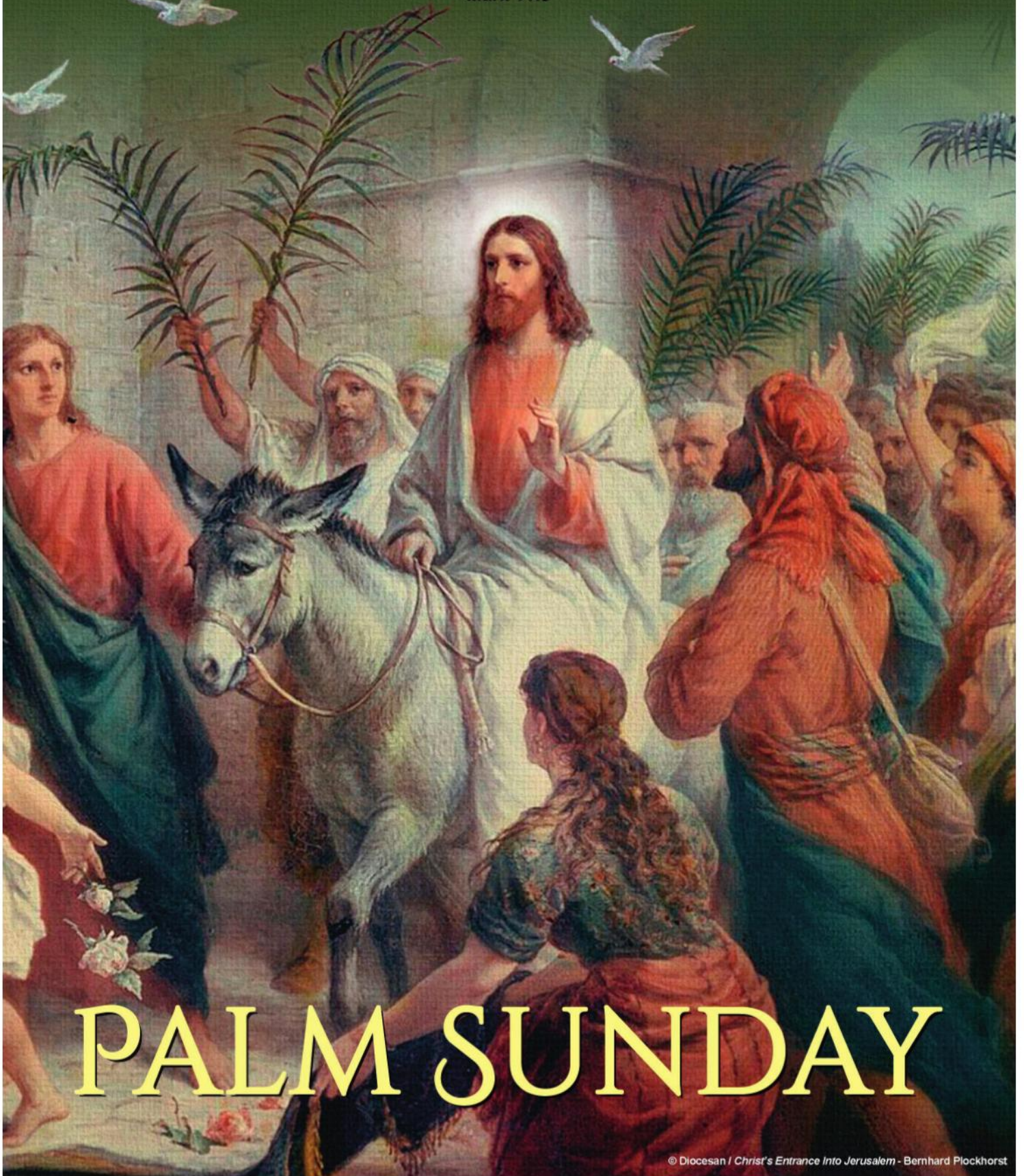

Palm Sunday

From Jesus' entry into Jerusalem and the triumphant emotions of the waving of the palms at the beginning of Mass to Mark's account of the passion during the liturgy—today's gospels fill us with emotions of joy for his arrival and sadness for his suffering. This dichotomy of feelings may leave you asking—Why does the Church opt for us to hear both readings at the beginning of Holy Week? To fully prepare us and allow us to see what Jesus accomplished. By calling our attention to the final week of Christ's life on earth, we can begin to understand his depth of love for everyone. During his suffering, he held *you* close to his heart.
