## LET US RETURN TO THE EUCHARIST WITH JOY!

A letter on the celebration of the liturgy during and after COVID 19 has been handed down to the bishops from Cardinal Sarah (*prefect of the* 

Congregation of Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments) on behalf of Pope Francis. Pope Francis expresses his deep desire that the faithful continue to obey their bishop's hygiene and safe distancing practices, as we have been here at St. Ignatius parish, with the understanding that for the benefit of our WHOLE being which includes our identity as the Catholic disciples of Jesus Christ, we must return to the Eucharist!

This week's relevant highlight as written by Cardinal Sarah:

"As much as the means of communication perform a valued service to the sick and those who are unable to go to church, and have performed a great service in the broadcast of the Holy Mass at a time when there was no possibility of community celebrations, no broadcast is compatible to personal participation or can replace it. On the contrary, these broadcasts alone risk distancing us from a personal and intimate encounter with the incarnate God who gave himself to us not in a virtual way, but really saying: "He who eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him." (John 6:56)


