The granting of this dispensation is not meant to be a reason to absent oneself from Mass (for other reasons). Conscience will always need to be our guide. If you are able to do so, I invite you to come back to the parish celebrations. Whether we are able to attend or not, we have a serious obligation to "Keep holy the Sabbath day." If you are not able to attend Mass, I ask that you set aside time for prayer, not only everyday but especially on Sunday.


