



#### THE SACRAMENTS AT ST. IGNATIUS OF LOYOLA CATHOLIC PARISH

The Diocese of Gaylord requires a three-year period of preparation for children receiving the sacraments of Reconciliation, Confirmation, and First Holy Communion. Children in grade one and their parents will begin sessions focused on Baptism. Children in the second grade together with their parents will prepare to receive Reconciliation. Children in the third grade will prepare for Confirmation and First Holy Communion along with their parents and sponsors.

Children who do not attend St. Ignatius School should begin faith formation classes in the first grade to lay a good foundation to receive the sacraments.

#### Faith Formation Classes

Registration for religious education classes is taking place now through September 9<sup>th</sup>.

Children in the first through fifth grade can register by filling out a form located in a blue folder at the church entrance.

#### Sacramental Preparation Classes

Children in the first, second, and third grades together with their parents will be preparing to receive the Sacraments through a series of five meetings held throughout the year.

Registration will take place at the following meetings.

The first Sacramental meeting for all parents and students will be held in the school computer room on:

Grade 1 – Monday September 21<sup>st</sup> at 6:30 pm

Grade 2 – Tuesday September 22<sup>nd</sup> at 6:30 pm

Grade 3 – Wednesday September 23<sup>rd</sup> at 6:30 pm

These meetings are important with information about your child's preparation for the Sacraments.



# STORIES THAT WILL PUT OUR MOMENTARY FAST FROM THE BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST INTO PERSPECTIVE.

Though not canonized, thousand & thousands of Japanese Christians lived without priests for nearly 250 years. They baptized their children in secret, passing down the faith in whispered lessons, praying before images of the Madonna and Child that were disguised to look like Buddhist images. In 1858 Japan finally readmitted Christian missionaries, who found 10,000 hidden Christians waiting for them. Imagine being raised with the near certainty that you would never in your life attend Mass, knowing of the Eucharist only because your grandmother's grandmother once went to Mass. *It puts social distancing in perspective*.

## Saint of the week- St. John Vianney, feast day August 4

Born near Lyon, France, this farmer's son studied for the priesthood for many years, and eventually was ordained more for his devoutness and good will than for other qualities. But he became a model parish priest in Arsen-Dombes, where he served for 40 years. He was devoted to his parishioners, and became famous for rigorous preaching and insights in the confessional. The Cure of Ars, as he was known, spent up to 18 hours a day hearing the confessions of pilgrims who sought him out. He is the patron of parish priests. *St. John Vianney...pray for Father Rolando!*


