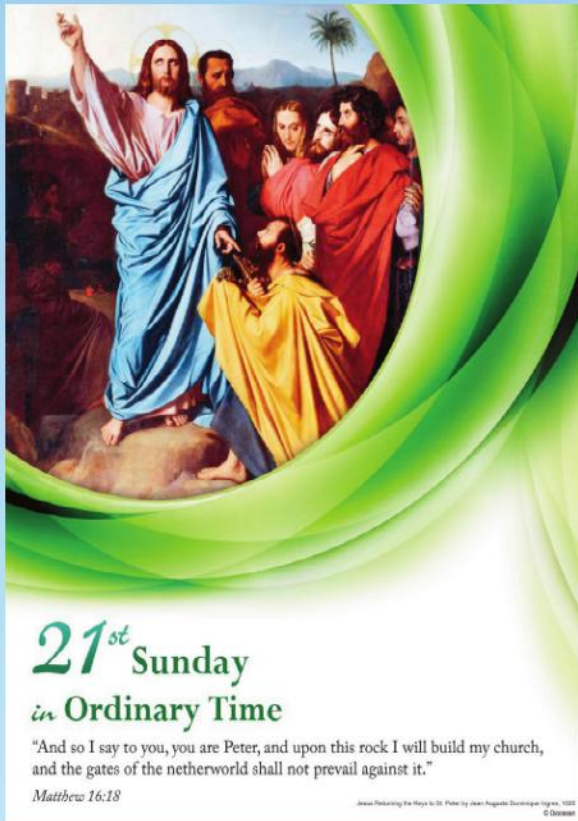

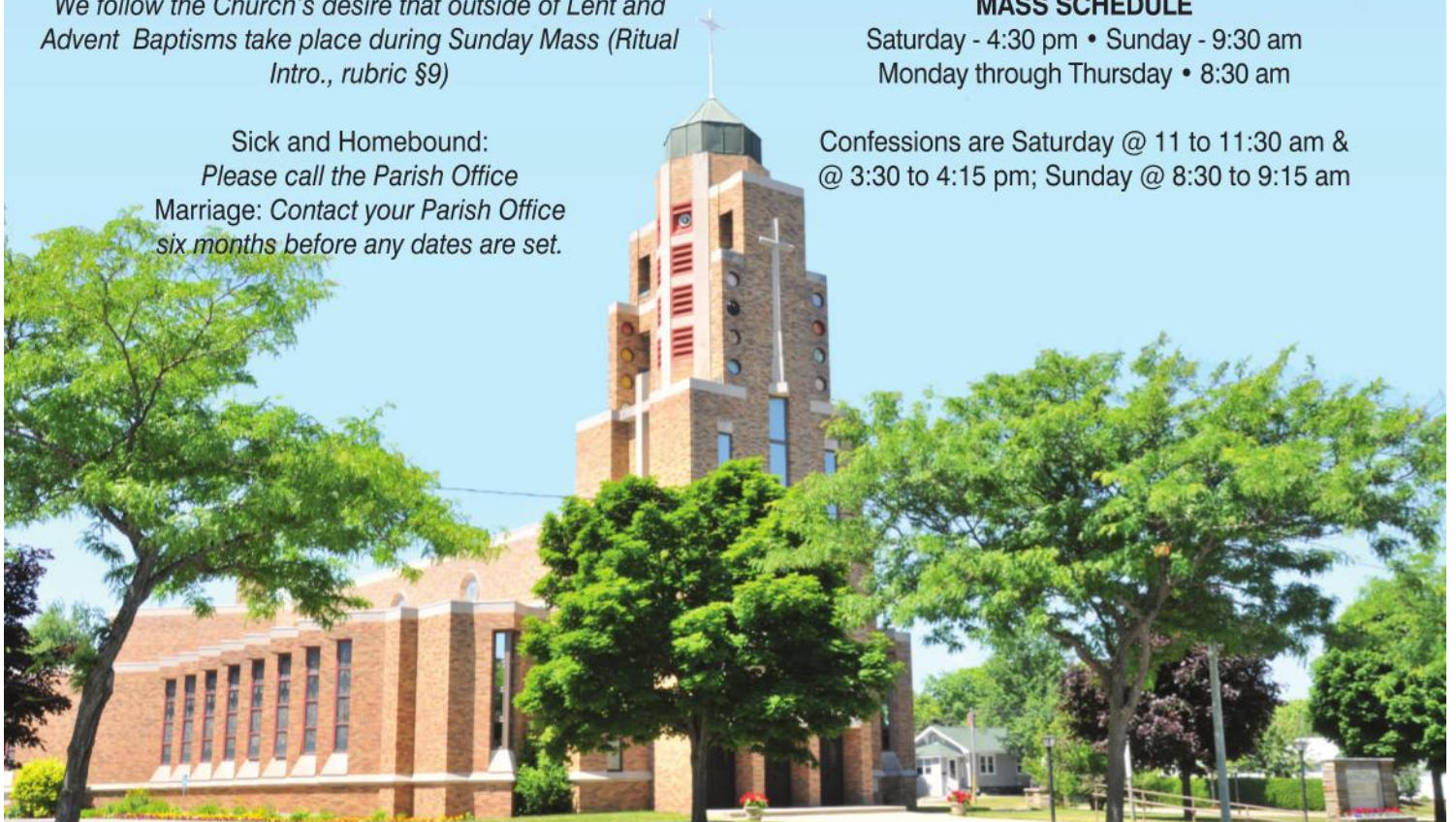

Father Rolando will be away on vacation from after Mass, August 16 to Saturday, September 4.

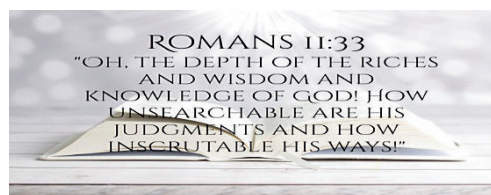
COUNCIL MEETINGS

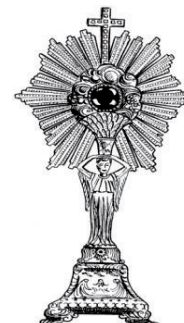

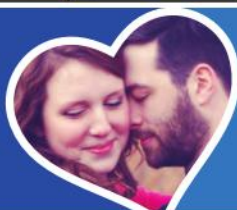
