



Eucharistic Revival – Missionary Sending

The fourth pillar/invitation of the **Eucharistic Revival** is what we are called to do when we are dismissed from Mass, "Go, forth the Mass is ended" or "Go and announce the Gospel of the Lord". With that word, "Go", our missionary work has just begun. We are to "Go" and make disciples by the witness of our own lives. Be a witness to those who are lost, to those who are the least, to those who are last.

In this year of Parish Revival, we are asked to initiate "Invite One Back" at our parish. Invision this, if every faithful, practicing Catholic invited one person who has either fallen away for whatever reason, invited them back to Mass, we would be on the path to renewing and filling our churches once again.

"Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations ... "(Mt: 28-19)

As Catholic Christians, one of our missions is to bring the "ever-present Life of God" into the world. Think about a time when you were invited to go somewhere, but you really didn't want to go, but you went anyways. What made you go? What made you unafraid?

The way we invite someone matters. Jesus knew how to invite. He was the greatest missionary that walked the Earth. He offered Peter to be "fishers of men". He called Matthew, the tax collector at the customs post. Jesus knew how to invite and to encourage the ones he invited, to do more than they were currently doing. Now it's our turn to seize this opportunity of missionary work and to invite others back under the care and guidance of the Holy Spirit.

What are we currently doing to encounter Jesus?

- Alpha share fellowship (meal, video, conversation) with someone you may or may not know.
- Coffee and donuts, parish breakfasts another opportunity for fellowship.

What more could we be doing to encounter Jesus?

- Facilitate volunteer efforts at area organizations in our community.
- Commit yourself to serving the poor, visit the homebound


