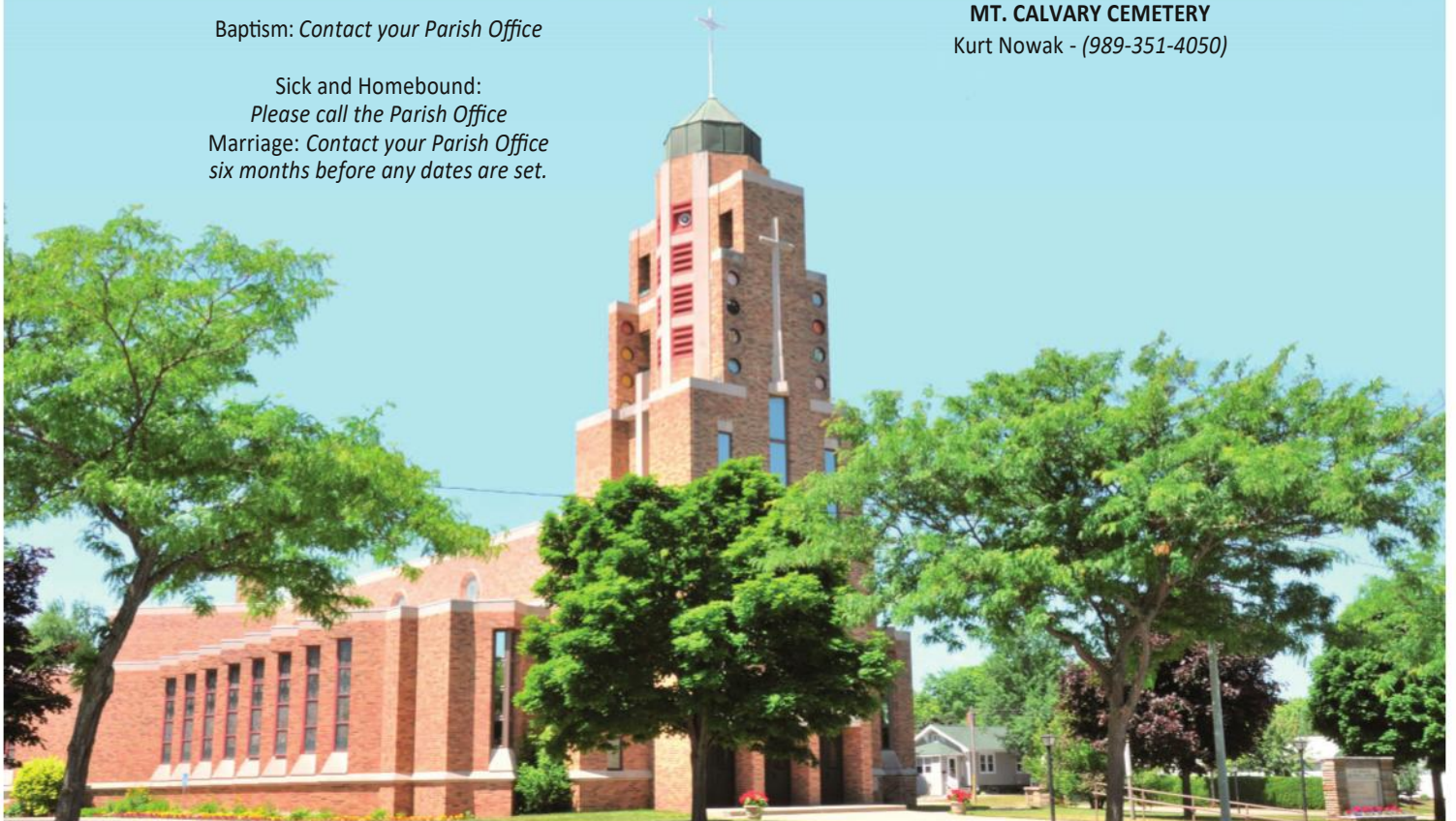

**YOUR GENEROSITY AT WORK...**

The Parish Office, formerly the convent for the nuns of St. Ignatius School, was built in 1941. In approximately 2019, the following maintenance work was performed.

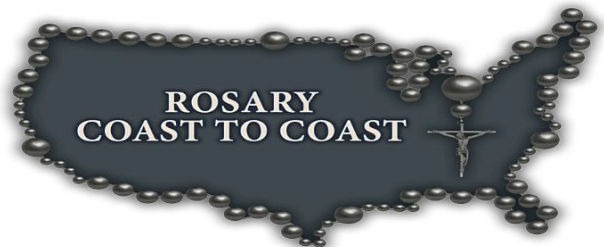
- All windows were wrapped in vinyl.
- The front and back metal awnings were removed and new awnings were installed.
- New gutters were installed to draw rain water away from the foundation.
- A new cement pad was poured at the back entrance to draw rain water away from the foundation.
- The trim around the front door was repaired and repainted.
- The front and back screen doors were replaced.
- A ½ bath was installed on the main floor.
- The basement was cleaned out.
- The upstairs linen closet was cleaned of outdated linens.
- Beds and dressers were removed from the upstairs.
- The upstairs plaster was repaired.
- An archives room was established.

In the future we are hopeful that the basement walls and floor can be waterproofed and painted. If you are available to volunteer any of your time during the winter months for this project, please contact us.
