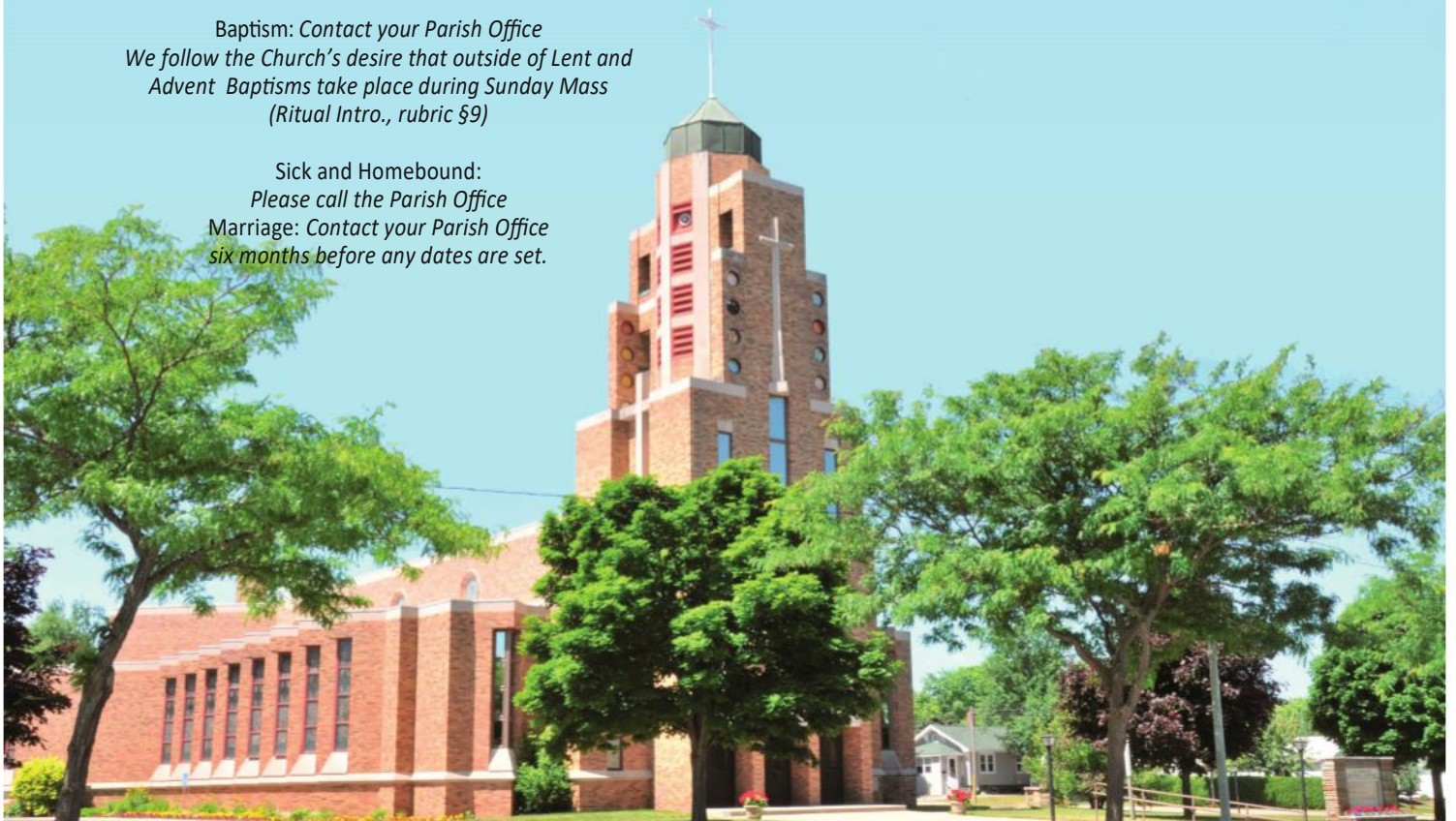

Eucharistic Revival – ROBUST FAITH FORMATION

This third pillar/invitation of the **Eucharistic Revival** revolves around us as disciples of Jesus Christ (**disciple means: a student or a follower of a teacher**) and how we should be on a continual path of learning from him. Thirsting more and more for his wisdom and knowledge.

“After three days they found Jesus in the temple, sitting in the midst of the teachers, listening to them and asking questions, and all who heard him were astounded at his understanding and his answers.” (Lk 2:46-47)

“When he saw the crowds, he went up the mountain, and after he had sat down, his disciples came to him. He began to teach them ...” (Mt 5:1-2)

Jesus, at a young age was attentive to being taught. Then once a teacher himself, he captivated the vast crowds that wished to listen and learn from him. This is at the heart of faith formation, listening, learning, understanding, and then sharing what you have learned with others.

The Body and Blood of Jesus is his Passion, Death, Resurrection, and Ascension. The Holy Eucharist also instructs “us how to live, how to pray and how love as he loves us.” As a faithful disciple, never stop believing in him, never stop hoping, never stop trying to live like him, and never stop **learning** from him!

What are we currently doing to **encounter** Jesus?

- St. Ignatius Bible Study – join – participate – learn.
- Alpha – teach and share with others your encounter with Jesus.

What more could we be doing to **encounter** Jesus?

- Participate in Eucharistic formation programs available on the National Eucharistic Revival Platform (check out the QR code on the banner in the sanctuary).

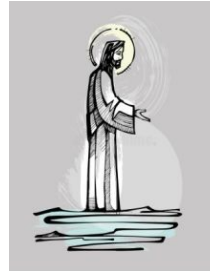


