



"YOUR GENEROSITY AT WORK"

Perhaps you have noticed a change in the lighting and the fans in St. Ignatius Church.

*Recently all the church lights were retrofitted with LED bulbs, new can lights were installed on the altar and new fans were installed.

*The chandeliers that were taken down years ago to accommodate the center aisle fans were cleaned and reinstalled in their original spots in the center aisle. *New fans were then installed in the center aisle. *The center aisle cove lights were repaired and are now functioning again with LED bulbs. The cost of this project was \$10,500.00 and was made possible in part by your generous donations to the improvement fund. The electrician estimates that we will have an 80% electrical savings for the church.

In the upcoming months, we will continue a maintenance report in the bulletin on projects that have been completed over the past few years.


