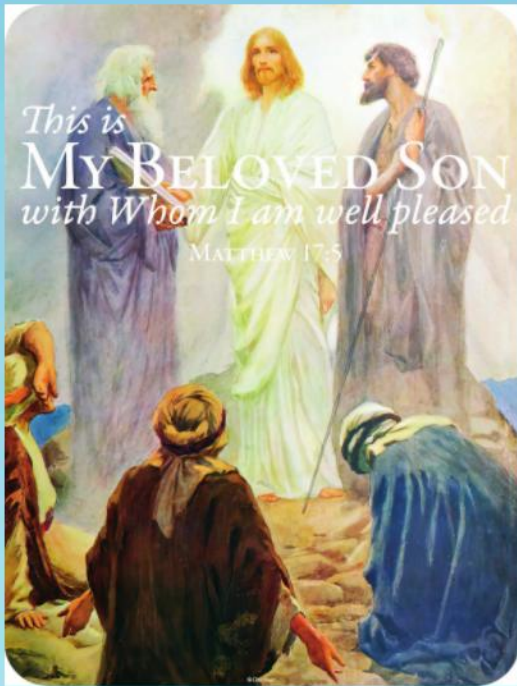

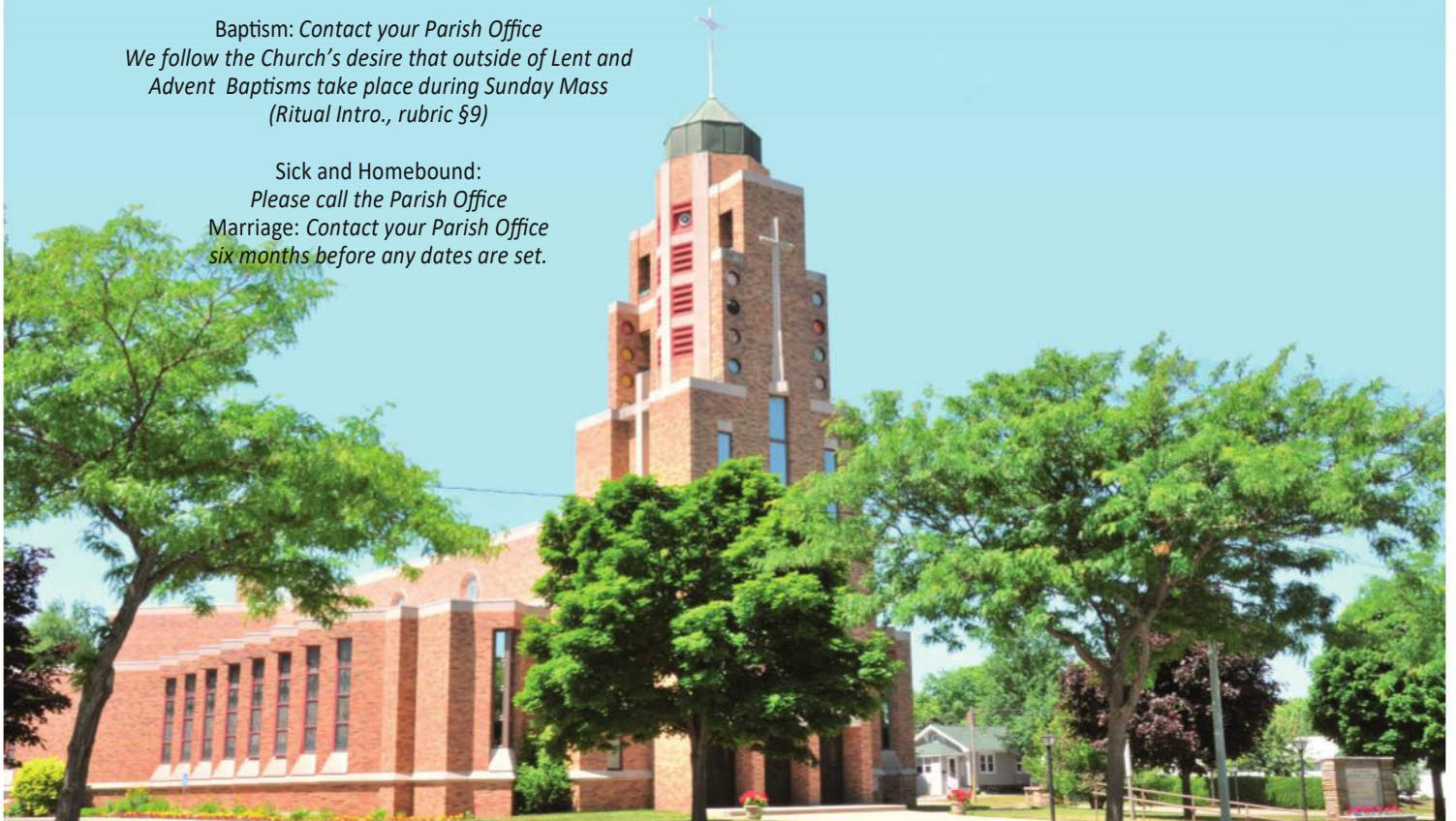

Eucharistic Revival – Personal Encounter

This second pillar/invitation of the **Eucharistic Revival** speaks directly to each disciple of Christ, to each and every one of us, who has chosen to follow him. Take a moment, and think of all the **personal encounters** that both men and women experienced during Jesus' life time.

There were the two disciples with John the Baptist as Jesus walked by, "Jesus turned and saw them following him and said, what are you looking for? They said to him, Rabbi, where are you staying? He said to them, Come, and you will see." (John 1:38-39)

There was Zacchaeus the Tax Collector who sought out Jesus by first climbing a Sycamore tree, "Zacchaeus, come down quickly, for today I must stay at your house." (Luke 19:5)

There was Martha and Mary, two sisters, one who served and the other who listened, "She had a sister named Mary who sat beside the Lord at his feet listening to him speak." (Luke 10:39)

Throughout all of Sacred Scripture there are many **personal encounters** with our Lord and Savior. Encounters that truly changed the hearts and the minds of those men and women. And, this is what the **Eucharistic Revival** is about, changing our hearts and our minds. Changing the 70% who look at the Eucharist as an "it" to 70% who look at the Eucharist as "who"! Can you recall the first time you encountered Jesus in the Eucharist? What happened to your heart? What happened to the direction of your life? Jesus is inviting all of us during this **Eucharistic Revival** to, "Come, and you will see" for he is the Living God, ever present in the Blessed Sacrament.

Weekly Eucharistic Adoration – time to listen to Him

Bi-weekly prayer gathering with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament

What more could we be doing to **encounter** Jesus?

Encourage your fellow parishioners to "Come and see" Jesus during Adoration and/or be a part of the prayer gatherings

Eucharistic parish retreat with a guest speaker

We are all invited to personally **encounter** Jesus in our lives and there is no greater way than through the Eucharist. Better yet, invite someone who has strayed from the church for whatever reason. Invite them back to God's House to "Come and see" for themselves, the love that Jesus Christ wants to, once again, share with them.

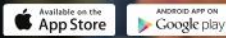
